## General Information

**Clinic Dates:** Friday, January 26th and Saturday, January 27th 2017

**On-Site Clinic Registration:** 10:00–10:45am – Memorial Hall Lobby

**NOTE:** **ONLY band directors** will be allowed to register their students, and directors are expected to stay on campus at UNC for the duration of the clinic. After registration, directors may take their students to their rehearsal site.

**Clinic Fee:** \$30.00 per student – payable to CDBA.

**NOTE:** School/Booster checks or cash only! Checks from students, parents or band directors **WILL NOT** be accepted.

**Health Forms:** Health forms are due at the registration table Friday, January 26th.

**NOTE:** All students **MUST** have a health form on file!

**Lodging:** Directors are responsible for arranging lodging and supervision for their students.

**Meals:** Your director is in charge of organizing your meals during the clinic, so please be sure to speak with them. There are many restaurants available on Franklin Street, which is in walking distance from the rehearsal sites.

**Recording:** A CD recording of the concert will be available for purchase.

CD's may be purchased on Saturday before and during the concert in the lobby of the Memorial Hall and will be shipped directly to the purchaser's address.

**Equipment:** All wind players and string bass players are responsible for providing their own instruments, supplies, and equipment called for by the music. General percussionists need to bring snare drums, concert toms auxiliary percussion, cymbals and hardware as called for by the music assigned to them in their folders: i.e., wood blocks, triangle, shakers, tambourines, etc. Percussionists are responsible for providing their own sticks and mallets, including chime, bass drum and mallets. All BIG percussion will be provided, i.e., Timpani, Keyboard instruments, Bass Drum, Gong, Concert Toms, Chimes, etc. (Much like at MPA). If there is any questions or concerns, please ask your director or contact Josh Cvijanovic for clarification.

**Music:** Students are responsible for having prepared their music before arriving at the clinic. This includes personal rehearsal, and the marking/taping of any music that requires such preparation. Please be certain to check that you have **ALL** of the music (and that it is the correct instrument and part assignment) and that all pages are legible and included in the PDF. If you think there is an error, please let your director know immediately so that the issue can be resolved BEFORE the clinic!

**Clothing:** Casual school clothing is acceptable for all rehearsals. Concert attire is as follows: Men – Dress pants, coat, tie, and dress shoes. Ladies – Dresses, skirts and blouses, or pantsuits and dress shoes. Attire should be all black. **NO BAND UNIFORMS!**

**Attendance:** Attendance at all rehearsals is **MANDATORY**. Students may not miss any portion of any rehearsal for any reason, including the SAT or college interviews of any kind. Students who must miss any of the rehearsals must give up their seat in the band. Please notify your director ASAP of any conflict, your director is to notify the clinic chair.

**Late Cancellations:** If for any reason a student will not be able to participate in the clinic at the last minute, the band director should notify the clinic chair as fast as possible so another student may participate in the clinic. If illness occurs on the day of the clinic, please notify your director as soon as it is determined that you will be unable to attend.

**Driving/Parking Directions:** Parking information for the Saturday concert at Memorial will be provided in a separate document.

**Concert:** We are very grateful to be guests on the campus of UNC Chapel Hill, and to perform in their beautiful Memorial Auditorium. Students and parents are encouraged to remain present for all the high school band performances. Following the concert, parents can meet their students in the lobby of Memorial Hall (they will **NOT** be allowed backstage).
